



Wayne Preece FWCF – Wayne qualified as a Farrier Dip. WCF. In October 1988 with honours! Each competitor must supply a freestanding workstation including up to date fire extinguisher, and use 20lb propane bottles. No trucks will remain in the arena.

Suitable Nails to be used. 6:30-7:30 am Setup

**Div I Judge Steve Dixon CJF. Forging I (60 min)**. Keg shoe,
Kerckhaert front size 1 modify to
Suspensory. Libero size 2 hind, modify to
a lateral extension.

**Forging II (60 min)**. Dutch front rt. 12"-3/8x1", 6 LX70 nails. Arab toe weight plain stamped. 12"-3/8x1", 6 LX70 nails. **Forging III (60 min).** Pair of concave hunter fronts, toe clipped, one stud hole lateral heel untapped. Six E5 slim, 3/8x3/4", circumference 14 3/8"

**Div II** Judge Wayne Preece FWCF Forging I (60 min). Pair of Hind heel preventers. 12 ½"- 3/4x7/16" concave. 6 nails, E5 slim. Clips Bob punched. Forging II (60 min). Donkey lft. front, 10 3/4"- 3/4x3/8" flat, plain stamped, 4 nails E3 slim, toe clip and heel caulks. Rt Hind 11 ½"- 3/4x3/8" flat, 4 nails E4 slim, toe clip and lateral fullered plus heel caulk.

**Forging III (60 min).** Pair of Hind, lateral extension. 12 ½"- 7/8x3/8"concave 6 nails E5 slim, toe clipped.

**Shoeing (70 min).** Shoe a pair of fronts, concave, Toe clipped, nails to suit. Fit TBA.

### Div III Judge Wayne Preece FWCF.

**Forging I (60min).** Front Rt. Aluminium, lateral extension. 12 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"- 1x3/8", 7 nails E5 slim, toe clip. Hind toe weight straight bar. 15 1/2"- 1x3/8". <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> fullered, 6 nails E5 slim

**Forging II (60min)** Pair of Morgan Hinds 11 ½"- 3/4x3/8"flat. Jumped in bar, ¼ clips, plain stamped, heel caulks, 7 nails E4 slim.

Forging III (60min) Left Roller Front. 12 1/4"- 3/4x1/2"flat. Plain stamped, 6 nails E4 slim, masolotte clip. Rt. Hind Roadster with toe bar. 11"- 1x1/2". Toe clip, 5/16 square for toe bar. 6 nails E6 slim.

Shoeing (70min) – Pair of 3/4 Fullered Hinds, quarter clipped with appropriate nails and bar stock. Fit TBA.
